- 3. Minutes**
- The minutes of the previous Parish Council meeting held on 6 November 2018 were read, approved and signed by the Chairman, having been proposed by Mrs Hale and seconded by Mr Pratt.
- 4. Matters arising**
- Siting of the bench to commemorate The Queen's 90th Birthday
The installation of the bench is in hand and Mr Pratt will donate additional slabs for the area on which the bench is to be placed.
 - Lay-by signage
This is in hand, the Parish Clerk is waiting for additional information from the Highways Officer.
 - "The Battle's Over" Beacon arrangements
It was agreed that this had been a huge success which had been very well attended both by Stanton St Bernard villagers and visitors from surrounding villages.
 - Cutting of bushes near children's playground
This is in hand
 - Salt Bag Scheme
The salt has been collected.
 - Raiser Chair
It was noted a thank you had been received from PCAP for the donation approved at the last meeting towards a raiser chair for South West Ambulance Service Trust.
- 5. Police Report**
- It was noted that as at the date of the meeting an updated Police Report had not yet been received but will be circulated upon receipt by the Parish Clerk to the Parish Councillors.
- 6. Wiltshire Councillor's Report**
- Mr Oatway explained the boundary review proposals had been accepted by Wiltshire Council and are now with the Boundaries Commission for approval, as mentioned at the last meeting. If approved All Cannings and Allington will become part of the Vale of Pewsey.
- The Pewsey Vale Campus / Health and Wellbeing Centre's official opening is on 22 February 2019.

There is a full meeting of Wiltshire Council next week to review the budget proposals.

7. Finance

- Bank Reconciliation
A bank reconciliation was circulated and reviewed, and having been agreed by all was signed. A copy is attached and forms part of these minutes.
- Payments
The following cheque was approved and signed:
£409.53 to Barlow & Sons on 12 February 2019 for the provision of timber for the replacement of the playground fencing. It was noted that a few extra posts and fixings are required and this was approved.

The Parish Clerk will circulate the website costs to the Parish Councillors for approval.

As considered at the last meeting, it was agreed to order plastic anti-bird spikes for the top of the swings, the quote for this being £35.

- Village Summer Party
Arrangements for the village summer party are underway by the Millennium Committee.

9. Any other business

- Ratification of planning application numbers
 - o 18/11419/LBC & 18/11025/FUL – Greywethers, Stanton St Bernard SN8 4LP – support
 - o 19/00381/FUL & 19/00575/LBC Prices Cottage, Fowlers Lane, Stanton St Bernard, SN8 4LP – supportThe above decisions made by the Parish Councillors following site visits were formally approved.
- Planning application number 19/00934/FUL - Nettles, Stanton St Bernard, SN8 4LF – it was agreed to support the planning application having conducted a site visit, and the Parish Clerk was asked to complete the necessary paperwork.
- Defibrillator Update
 - o The electricity supply is finally being connected on 15 March 2019, electricity having been kindly supplied by the neighbouring property.
 - o It was agreed that an email be circulated asking for volunteers to check the defibrillator on a daily basis on a rota basis. All that is required is to check that the button is green which can be done without having to access the telephone kiosk. The Parish Clerk was asked to organise this.
 - o Annual defibrillator training is provided and Mr Read will try to organise this for some time in April.

Any other business

- All Cannings School Bus
It was noted that children are being picked up by the bus in the road rather than from the Village Hall carpark. It was agreed not to query this as it is probably safer for the children to be picked up closer to their houses.

- Post and barbed wire
It was noted that a post and barbed wire needed replacing near Forge Cottage, it was agreed that this is the landowners responsibility.
- B4003 proposed road closure
The B4003 from West Kennett to Avebury could be closed to traffic, or made one way, if a traffic calming proposal by the transport group on Avebury's parish council is adopted. It was noted that this would increase mileage for villagers and surrounding villages travelling to Swindon. It was agreed to look into this further, and if able to do so object to the proposals.
