8. Village Hall and village matters

- Village Hall
The redecoration of the Village Hall has been completed.
- Covid-19
Mrs Tarver explained there had been two “call outs” for help in the village, both being for the collection of prescriptions.

9. Any other business

- Road Safety
It was noted a villager had experienced a near miss in his car by a vehicle speeding through the village. It was reported at the last meeting that several villagers had complained about vehicles speeding through the village and that there had been an increase in delivery vehicles due to the Covid19 lockdown and restrictions, with more villagers ordering on-line and having deliveries to their homes.
It was agreed the Parish Clerk contact Mr Oatway to see about the feasibility of a 20 mile per hour speed limit in the village, it being noted that the villages of All Cannings and Lockeridge now have 20 mile per hour speed limits.
- Overgrown footpath
Mr Read said he would look at the overgrown footpath near church walk which needs clearing.
- Ratification of support to 20/09208/LBC and 20/09276/VAR - air-source heat pump at Prices Cottage, Fowlers Lane, Stanton St Bernard, Wilts, SN8 4LP on 3 December 2020
The above decision made by the Parish Councillors on 3 December 2020 was formally approved.
- Water Pumps for the Pewsey Community Area
It was agreed a water pump is not needed in the village.
- Safety fence around Winterbourne / Playing field gate and fence repair
The current fence, which was originally installed for safety reasons, has been kicked down making the area dangerous. There is also wood blockage from the old fence in the ditch which is being washed down and causing a possible flood risk.
It was also noted the playing field gate was not closing properly, and that part of the fence needed repairing.
It was agreed to ask Hartley Landscaping Services to provide a quote to repair all the above.
- Streetlight
The streetlight outside Mrs Hale’s house and the one at the Village Hall are still not working. Mr Read said he would contact Wiltshire Council to chase the repairs.
- Any other business:
 - Dogs’ Mess
Dogs’ mess has been reported in the Children’s Playground and elsewhere in the village. It was noted that dogs are not allowed in the Children’s Playground but the signs keep being removed. The Parish clerk was asked to investigate the price of more substantial signs which would be harder to remove.
 - Parish Steward Priority Worksheet
The Parish Clerk was asked to notify the Parish Steward that the pothole outside Cherry Tree Lodge needs repairing

Next Meeting The next meeting will be on Thursday 18 March 2021 at the Village Hall, or via Zoom if Covid-19 restrictions are still in place.
